Borderland.online is a platform that addresses and represents the lived experiences of people inhabiting European border regions. Its goal is to preserve and pass on the incredible diversity of cultures of European borderlands and make these life histories accessible for educational purposes.

Borderland Stories is a multilateral, transnational, interdisciplinary project, which combines ethnographic analysis and creative work in the visual arts to facilitate intercultural communication across two distinct, ostensibly disparate European borderlands. Borderland Stories has brought together students and teachers from Saarland University (Germany) and Petro Mohyla Black Sea National University of Mykolaiv (Ukraine), as well as artists, journalists and independent researchers. From this wellspring of academic and creative input, students have produced a total of 10 outstanding, cutting-edge media projects in the form of landing pages, a selection of which you will find exhibited at Mudam.
